40TH YEAR OF OPERATIONS IN NORTHERN NEVADA. MOANA NURSERY HAS
PROVIDED LANDSCAPING, EROSION CONTROL SERVICES AND RELATED

SERVICES TO SOMERSETT DEVELOPMENT SINCE 1999. THANK YOU FOR
THE OPPORTUNITY TO PROVIDE THE COMMISSION WITH SOME VERY BRIEF
REMARKS CONCERNING OUR EXPERIENCE WITH MR. BLAKE SMITH, THE

QUALITY OF HIS PROJECTS, AND HOW HE HONORS HIS COMMITMENTS.

WHILE MOANA HAS, AND CONTINUES TO WORK WITH MANY

DEVELOPERS, INCLUDING NATIONAL "BIG-5" FIRMS, NONE DO MORE IN TERMS

OF DELIVERING HIGH-QUALITY PROJECTS INTEGRATED INTO THE

ENVIRONMENT. WE'VE SEEN MR. SMITH WORK CLOSELY WITH HIS

ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS TO ENSURE THEY EXECUTE HIS VISION, WHILE DELIVERING BOTH AMENITIES, AND PROVIDING SENSIBLE INTERFACE WITH THE EXISTING ENVIRONMENT.
